



We all know business is really about people. You want the best working with you, and you want the contacts who'll enable you and your organisation to flourish. It's not about settling for what you can get; it's about ensuring your business has the talent to make it work.

With two Teaching Excellence Framework Gold-standard universities, spanning creative and academic fields, Norwich is packed with homegrown talent.

The University of East Anglia (UEA) is ranked in the UK Top 30 (*The Times* and *Sunday Times*), and World Top 200 Universities. UEA is renowned for its business school, cutting-edge environmental science research and creative writing, and is home to the iconic Sainsbury Centre for Visual Arts. And – with its city centre campus – Norwich University of the Arts (NUA) was ranked in the top 10 for teaching quality in the National Student Survey 2021, and is ranked in the top two creative arts universities by the *Complete University Guide* 2023, with graduates in design, film, architecture and more.

For young learners, there are 79 schools, 20 of which are 'Outstanding' Ofsted rated. Norwich boasts 36 primary schools serving 10,549 students for the 2022 school year! And at City College Norwich, a brand-new dedicated digital skills institute engages teenage innovators. Going to school here means getting off on the right foot.

It is no wonder our workforce is packed with highly skilled people or that we have a large economically active population. The city draws people in from around the region; Norwich is a professional hub for a large catchment, pulling talent from Norfolk, Suffolk and Cambridgeshire.

And one of the really unique strengths of Norwich? Our community. Our businesses pull together, allowing the whole city to thrive. Our start-up retention rate is 43.2%, and we know that part of that is because of the richness of the city's networks and our ability to collaborate. In Norwich, we have a vested interest in everybody succeeding – because we know that what's good for one business is good for the whole.

#### Norwich is a Centre for Cities Fast Growth City – recognition of its high economic potential.

For retail and leisure, Norwich remains bustling and busy, with a diverse high-street. The Cambridge-Norwich Tech Corridor has supported a rapidly growing digital scene, while the Norwich Research Park draws top talent from around Europe. Commercial businesses are thriving: from law to finance to insurance – there's a reason Norwich has been home to one of the largest insurance centres in the UK for over 200 years.

There are lots of reasons why Norwich is a brilliant business base. Norfolk is home to the largest free-to-access public sector IoT (internet of things) network in the UK and is about to benefit from a £50 million investment in high-speed broadband – that means a lot less time waiting for Teams to load, and a lot more time to focus on getting the job done. You'll also be able to benefit from all the best tech talent, whether that's experienced web and app developers, software engineers, VR experts or something else entirely. And costs will be much lower too – rent prices in Norwich are around 20% lower than the national average, keeping overheads competitive and maximising benefits.

If working sustainably is a business priority, we can help. The county's offshore windfarms will help supply green energy to power more than four million UK homes. Norwich City Council aims to be net zero carbon by 2030, and we're pioneering new circular economy initiatives across the city.

The urban area of Norwich is among the top 10 fastest-growing urban centres in the country, and has recently been awarded a Town Deal, which will help to accelerate its growth. The City Council and local leadership have a vision for the future: to celebrate and grow Norwich as a creative, liveable, fair, connected, and dynamic city. And they're working together with local businesses and communities to make it happen.
